12:30-12:40	STORYTIME	Teacher select material
12:40-1:10	ARITHMETIC	Board work, slate work, drills
1:10-1:45	MEMORY WORK	Recite a previously assigned poem
1:45-2:00	SUMMARY & CLEAN UP	Journal-writing activity. Writing in the Copy Book
